

TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 CAMPER OR STAFF PROTOCOL

Campers or staff who test positive for COVID-19 must be isolated from other campers/staff and excluded from the camp for at least 5 days. Isolation ends after 5 full days if the individual is fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and other symptoms have improved. Masking continues to be required upon return from isolation during days 6 through 10. Individuals must wear a well-fitted mask and should social distance. If unable to wear a well-fitted mask the entire time at the facility, they may not return for 10 days.

COVID-19 EXPOSURE CAMPER OR STAFF PROTOCOL

If a camper or staff member is exposed to Covid-19 at camp, we will take the following measures.

NON-VACCINATED

For asymptomatic non-vaccinated campers and staff, we will require mask wearing from the date of the exposure or potential exposure (Day 0) and testing at least twice through day 5. Testing on Day 5 after exposure will be required to detect infection among individuals identified as exposed or potentially exposed. Masking continues to be required during days 6 through 10. Individuals must wear a well-fitted mask and should social distance. If unable to wear a well-fitted mask the entire time at the facility, they may not return for 10 days.

VACCINATED (UP TO DATE)

Asymptomatic campers and staff who are up to date with vaccines or have recovered from laboratory confirmed COVID-19 in the previous 3 months may remain at camp. Testing on Day 5 after exposure will be required to detect infection among individuals identified as exposed or potentially exposed.
